4.—(1.) For the purposes of this Ordinance, there shall be a constitution of Trust. Trust which shall consist of seven trustees, residents of Norfolk Island, who shall be nominated by the Administrator and appointed by the Minister Ammistance Executive menishing

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(2.) The trustees shall hold office for a period of two years

and shall be eligible for re-appointment.

(3.) Where the office of a trustee becomes vacant before the substituted by expiration of the period of his appointment, the Minister may No. 4, 1953, appoint a person to the vacant office for the balance of that period.

(4.) The Trust shall be a body corporate by the name of the Norfolk Island Public Hall Trust and shall have perpetual succession and a common seal.

(5.) The powers and capacities of the Trust may exercised by any five of the trustees.

5.—(1.) The land described in the Schedule to this Ordinance together with all buildings thereon and appurtenances thereto is hereby vested in the Trust for an estate in fee simple upon trust for the use and benefit of the people of Norfolk Island for the purpose of a public hall and for no other purpose ···batsoever.
