In the Wastewater Working Group meeting this morning I made reference to PFAS being identified in Watermill Creek and Watermill Dam in Senversa'a preliminary site investigation (PSI).

The results from the PSI were released to the community in March 2021 (together with an <u>Executive Summary</u>, <u>Fact Sheet relevant Media Release</u>).

In the <u>full report from the preliminary investigation</u> there is reference to:

- results from surface water samples taken from Watermill Creek and Watermill Dam (page 26)
- freshwater aquatic flora present in surface waters in locations including Watermill Dam being a potential ecological receptor (refer 6.4.2 Ecological on page 36).
