rang the other day to inform me of possibility of PFAS contamination in the water hyacinth being delivered to the Waste Management Centre.

We have accepted this FOC as we intend to make compost that will be available to the public to recover the cost of processing. What we intend to do is isolate this compost in case it needs testing.

If testing for PFAS is required this will be at the Departments expense as will the cost of appropriate disposal if PFAS is present.

The compost will be in the Hotrot for about 10 days then it cures for 6-7weeks. After this time I will not have anywhere to store it and the curing bays will be needed for the new batches of compost.

Can yourself or advise at your earliest convenience if testing is required and what we need to do get the samples off island.
