SUMMARY

REGULAR AIRLINE PASSENGER SERVICE UPDATE

Air New Zealand flight have had disruptions to some of their scheduled flights during January with Australia having changes to their border restrictions for New Zealand travellers. This meant that Air New Zealand crew and planes were temporarily not available to conduct the Norfolk Island schedule which disrupted several flights during the last week of January.

Qantas operated two repatriation flights to Norfolk Island on 31 January 2021. Thanks go to the Commonwealth for organising these flights.


