## EXPERIENCE NORFOLK ISLAND... YOUR WAY - HOLIDAY COMPETITION

The 'Experience Norfolk Island... Your Way' holiday competition which ran during November and December was drawn on 23 December 2020 and the winners are Mr & Mrs McCullough from Queensland. Applicants were asked to choose the type of holiday they would like to win (Wellness, Flavour, or Nature) The campaign results were excellent with good activity to the NI Tourism website as well as social media.

- 194,366 people were reached
- 12,514 unique entries
- 10,926 survey completions (if survey was completed they received additional entry credits)
- Nature experience was the most popular experience, with 49.6% of votes
- Flavour experience received 35.2% votes
- Wellness experience received 15.2%
- Of the survey entrants, 9% of respondents (989) are looking to travel in the next 0-2 months, and 31.9% (3,480) are looking to travel in the next 3-6 months.
