EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF COUNCIL – 18 MARCH 2021

An extraordinary meeting of Council was held on Thursday 18 March, to consider two urgent matters, which were determining the outcome of Tenders as part of the Commonwealth Stimulus Funding projects.

7.1 Tender Evaluation - Bicentennial Centre Refurbishment: Labour Only Resolution 2021/23

The Interim Administrator resolved the following:

- 1) That the Painting works contract be awarded to Avoca Painting.
- 2) That the Construction works, including plumbing, electrical, steel, construction, flooring, plastering, tiling, carpeting be awarded to J Sanders Construction; noting that plumbing and electrical works will be sub-contracted.

7.2 Tender Evaluation Footpath - Airport to Burnt Pine Project Resolution 2021/24

The Interim Administrator resolved the following:

- 1) That the tenders received in response to RFT 27/2020 be rejected in accordance with Clause 178 (1) (b) of the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005 Part 7 Tendering.
- 2) That in accordance with Clause 178 (3) (e) of the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005 Part 7 Tendering, Council enter into negotiations with any person (whether or not the person was a tenderer) with a view to entering into a contract in relation to the subject matter of the tender.
