

ROAD CLOSURE TO REMOVE DANGEROUS ROCKS

Norfolk Island Regional Council (NIRC) in conjunction with, the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications (DITRDC) wish to advise that works are currently being planned to remove over hanging boulders at the lower section of Taylors Road.

The final dates for the Road Closure are currently being discussed with the contractor and is likely to commence late May or early June, and will be announced on Radio Norfolk, NIRC Face Book Social Media site and on the Norfolk Island Regional Council Website.

Road Barriers and signs will be in place at various locations leading to and including the work site.

Due to the high level of risk associated with the removal of the rocks, during closure including overnight operations; motorists and the public are asked to observe all signs prohibiting entrance to the worksite, during the full 24 hour period of closure.

The works are expected to take up to 4 days and is subject to engineering inspection as the work progresses, which may result in a requirement to extend the closure period.



Residents of Taylors Road, will still have access to and from their homes from Channer's Corner.

Please be aware, you will not have access to Taylors Road from Country Road.

All other motorists and pedestrians are asked to take alternate routes to get to and from Kingston.

We wish to apologise for any inconvenience caused, but these works are essential in order to ensure continued safety to the Public.
