

Community Planting Days

Over the next few months, NIRC will be holding four planting days in different reserves around the island. The community is welcome to come along and help in the rehabilitation of these precious and varied ecosystems by planting a few trees and contributing first-hand to the preservation of our waterways, coastal vegetation and native forest.

Sunday 23rd May: Two Chimneys Reserve

Rehabilitating the coastal vegetation around the picnic area and down towards the lookout.

Easy access, the ground is mostly flat however there are some steeper areas.

Sunday 6th June: Ball Bay Reserve

Replicating and diversifying the native forest along the old creekline.

Moderate access, friendly to most ages.

Sunday 20th June: Bumboras Reserve

Working to revegetate and stabilise the areas around the creek and the boardwalk down to Bumboras Beach.

Moderate access, some areas might be muddy and slippery.

Date to be confirmed: Cockpit (Cascade) Reserve

Rehabilitation of the creekside vegetation and preservation of habitat for our native freshwater species.

Easy access, mostly flat with a few possibly slippery areas.

This particular planting has been taken on by years 5 and 6 at school however it is open to everyone else as well that would like to be apart of it.

These dates may change slightly, updates will be given closer to the time
