Rating Model on Public Exhibition

Under the applied local government legislation, there are certain items that the Council must place on public exhibition for 28 days before adopting, one of these items is a rating model.

When a document, or series of documents, is put on public exhibition it is available for the public to comment. You can submit comments to Council in the following ways:

In-person: in a sealed envelope delivered to Customer Care

By email: regionalcouncil@nirc.gov.nf

By post: PO Box 95, Norfolk Island 2899

All submissions must be marked with the subject, and a reference to the document on public exhibition i.e. Public Submission Rating Model; submissions must be received on or before the closing date to be considered.

All public submissions are collated and reviewed at the close of the exhibition period, a summary of submissions is then presented to the Council in the body of the report about the proposed changes. This document is publicly available and can be found on Councils website by navigating to *Your Council>Council Meetings*.

The proposed rating model for 2021-2022 is now available for public exhibition, the closing date and time for comment is Friday 4 June 2021 at 4:00 pm NI time.
