

ROAD CLOSURE TO REMOVE DANGEROUS ROCKS

Norfolk Island Regional Council (NIRC) in conjunction with, the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications (DITRDC) wish to advise that the lower half of Taylors Road will be closed to all through traffic commencing Monday 31st May.

Full closure is expected to be over 4- 5 days to allow for the safe removal of rock and the reshaping of the bank.



Due to the high level of risk associated with the removal of the rocks, during the operations and overnight closure, motorists and public are asked to observe all signs, and are asked not to enter into the worksite, during the full period of closure (24 hour periods). Road Barriers and signs will be in place at various locations leading to and including the work site.

The works are expected to take up to 4 days and is subject to engineering inspection as the work progresses, which may result in a requirement to extend the closure period.

Residents of Taylors Road will still have access to and from their homes from Channer's Corner. Please be aware, you will not have access to Taylor Road from the Country Road. All other motorists and pedestrians are asked to take alternate routes to get to and from Kingston.



We wish to apologise for any inconvenience caused, but these works are essential in order to ensure continued safety to the Public.
