Change in Traffic Conditions – Roundabout Current Works

Norfolk Island Regional Council would like to advise motorists that construction works to lift the road level on the left lane towards the airport - Taylor Road to Ferny Lane, section of the new roundabout, commencing Monday 12th July, weather permitting.

This means that a small section of lane will be closed for approximately 7 or more days and will require a small diversion around the new surface.

During this period, the Roundabout will convert back to a “T” type intersection, and witches’ hats and signs will be in place as required.

It is extremely important that all motorists drive slowly through this site, driving to the conditions of the diversion, observing the “T” intersection rule and all signage in place.

Norfolk Island Regional Council apologises for any inconvenience caused nearing the final stages of construction.
