



How to present your household waste to the Waste Management Centre

All general waste should be sorted into the various waste streams (shown in the diagram below) BEFORE it is delivered into the centre



Steel, Aerosol & Aluminium Cans

Place in the chutes provided without plastic bags. Don't forget that scrunched up foil can also be recycled



Glass Bottles & Jars

These should be emptied and placed into the chute provided

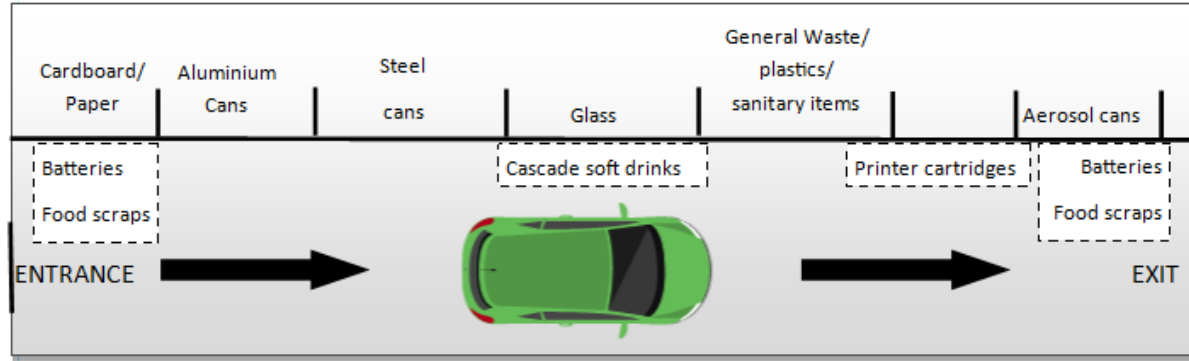


Food Scraps & Organics

Must be separated from your general waste and placed into the bins provided **Please remove from plastic bag or bucket before placing into the bin.**
If you have compostable bags they can be placed in the bins

Plastics

There is also a dedicated chute for plastic waste. This chute is for plastic bottles and hard plastics. All soft plastics and packaging should be placed with your general waste.



Household Batteries

Can be toxic to the receiving environment and must be separated from the general waste



Nappies & Other Sanitary Items

Deliver in a separate, sealed, plastic bag a place in the general rubbish chute



Printer Cartridges

By separating and placing in the bins provided Council will be able to send these for recycling



Items & Clothing deemed to have a reuse value can be placed in the reuse area on the right hand

Items that are not mentioned above will be assessed by an Authorised Waste Management Officer.
