The Norfolk Island Fire Service appreciates the Community involvement in utilising the **EMERGENCY '000'**, for reporting Emergencies involving fires and incidents where our services are required. Please bear in mind this number is specifically for this purpose **'EMERGENCIES ONLY'**.

For ALL OTHER enquiries please utilise telephone number **22049** during business hours as this does not activate the Emergency Reporting System to all Fire Staff, especially on their days off.

- Will it affect my neighbors? (Health & Well-being)
- Are the conditions favorable? (Wind speed and direction, have I enough time so not to leave unattended, cleared the surrounds, available fire protection, no children)
- Have I advised the Fire Service (22049)?
- Will I need assistance, (the Fire Service is available during BH's for this purpose for a fee)?
