#### Waste Exports

The following table summarizes the waste exports for the month of August and the year to date

#### Waste Stockpile for Export

The below Table 1 is the waste that is currently stockpiled and sealed in containers for export. Table 2 is an estimate of current stockpiles that are uncontainerised. The scrap metal is an estimate of waste processed through the car baler. Uncompacted cars and other metals are yet to be estimated. The total estimated waste for export is 315.85 tonnes.

**Composting**

The Hotrot Composting facility has been operating at nearly full capacity as Waste Management has been able to access a loader on a regular basis. This has meant butchers waste can be fed into the bone grinder and the green waste can be processed through the Telcor mulcher.

The water hyacinth from Water Mill Dam has finally been processed through the system. As this is potentially contaminated with PFAS it has been isolated and will be returned to the site for remediation work.
