

Camping at Emily Bay

The Norfolk Island Regional Council has made the difficult decision to ask campers to vacate their campsites at Emily Bay due to the risks on island currently posed by COVID. NIRC is cognisant of the pressures on the island's health system and wishes to take measures to assist.

Campers are asked to vacate by Thursday 6 January and to exercise social distancing and safe hygiene practices.

Campers are able to leave their tents to be packed up progressively after tomorrow.

This decision has been taken to manage the spread of COVID on the island and keep the community safe. We thank all campers for doing the right thing to date and ask for their cooperation in this matter. There will be no recommencement of camping during this holiday period.
