

Council Service Area Update

Customer Care

The Customer Care office is open to the public Monday to Friday, 9am - 4pm. Due to resource shortages, the office will close each day for half an hour between approximately 12 and 12.30pm.

To assist Customer Care in complying with EMNI requirements, the following restrictions are in place:

- Only two (2) people are permitted inside at any one time.
- All persons must sanitise and sign in before entering the premises.
- All persons must wear a mask.

Waste Management Centre

The Waste Management Centre (WMC) has also made changes to their operations to comply with EMNI social distancing requirements (4sqm/person rule). The following restrictions are now in place:

- Only two (2) cars will be permitted to unload at any one time.
- All persons must wear a mask and follow the WMC staff instructions.
