

RAINFALL CAUSES LANDSLIDES ACROSS NORFOLK

Last weekend the island received over 140mm of rain, causing landslides around the Ball Bay, Bloody Bridge, and Bombouras Reserve.

The Works Depot worked tirelessly over a 48 hour period to stabilise the three areas across the island, to re-establish road access for use by the public and visitors alike.

The roads were cleared using a variety of Works Depot equipment including excavators, dump trucks and graders, and re-rolled where appropriate.

Further degradation witnessed on Taylors Road was also patched throughout the week.

With the ongoing weather events, the roads will be assessed towards the end of the month to assess if additional repairs are required.

Some of the repairs may include rerouting stormwater drains, re-patching the road network, and replanting vegetation.

Thank you to the Works Depot Team for their ongoing work in catering for the current weather events experienced by Norfolk Island.
