Consultant, Cristelle Maurin, has worked with community representatives over a 12-month period to develop the strategy. The documents on exhibition include the detailed strategy and a separate document containing the priorities to support a food secure island.

The community is encouraged to make submissions on the strategy, in particular the priorities and initiatives to support its implementation. If there are initiatives that are not already identified in the strategy, community members are encouraged to make submissions in relation to these.
